EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER LIFTING THE MUNICIPALITY OF NAGA'S
ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND PLACING THE SAID
MUNICIPALITY IN GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE IN ACCORD
WITH THE NATIONAL GUIDELINES ISSUED BY INTER-AGENCY TASK
FORCE AND ADOPTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES**

WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines on April 30, 2020, has issued Executive Order No. 112 adopting the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases on April 29, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Naga, Zamboanga Sibugay, by virtue of Section 16 of RA 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 which states that every Local Government Unit (LGU) shall exercise the powers essential to the promotion of the general welfare or otherwise known as the General Welfare Clause and that LGUs shall promote health and safety of their inhabitants, is hereby adopting the said Executive Order No. 112 and is hereby placing the entire Municipality of Naga, Zamboanga Sibugay under General Community Quarantine;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RINO O. DELOS REYES, Municipal Mayor of Naga, Zamboanga Sibugay, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE, GUIDELINES.

1. No one shall be allowed to go out of their residences without a face mask or other protective gear which will prevent the further spread of COVID-19;
2. Any person below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidities, or other health risks, and pregnant women, shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, except when indispensable under reasonable circumstances;
3. Movement of all persons in areas placed under General Community Quarantine shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, and for work in the offices or industries permitted to operate;

4. Amusement, gaming, and fitness establishments, as well as those in the kids and the tourism industries are still prohibited;
5. Physical classes are still suspended for the duration of the General Community Quarantine, without prejudice to Higher Education Institutions which may hold classes through flexible learning arrangements and may operate at a limited capacity to receive students' requirements and prepare and issue credentials to students subject to guidelines as may be issued by the Commission on Higher Education;
6. Mass gatherings, such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, religious gatherings, and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited;
7. Public transportation shall be allowed to operate at a reduced capacity, provided, that in all public transports, a strict one (1) meter distance between passengers shall be observed;
8. Curfew hours previously issued shall remain valid and effective;
9. Strict physical and social distancing shall be observed at all times for the duration of the General Community Quarantine;
10. Sectors or industries allowed to operate:
 - a. CATEGORY I INDUSTRIES – Agriculture, fishery, and forestry industries, food manufacturing and food supply chain businesses, including food retail establishments such as supermarkets, grocery stores, and food preparation establishments insofar as take-out and delivery services, food delivery services, health-related establishments, the logistics sector, information technology and telecommunication companies, the media, at full operational capacity;
 - b. CATEGORY II INDUSTRIES – Mining and other manufacturing; export-oriented, and electronic commerce companies, as well as other delivery, repair and maintenance, and housing and offices services, at anywhere between fifty percent (50%) up to full operational capacity, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements; and
 - c. CATEGORY III INDUSTRIES – Financial services, BPOs, legal and accounting services, professional, scientific, technical, and other non-leisure services, barber shops, salon, and other personal care services as defined by the DTI, and other non-leisure wholesale and retail establishments, at a maximum of fifty percent (50%) work-on-site arrangement, and without prejudice to work-from-home and other alternative work arrangements;
11. Sectors allowed to operate must implement safety and precautionary measures to prevent the further spread of the virus and in no manner shall they allow clients, consumers or the people in general with unnecessary stay and loiter within their premises;
12. Municipal border checkpoints shall continue to operate and function to monitor and regulate persons coming in and out of the Municipality.

Checkpoint personnel must ensure that all entry and exit shall be limited to essential purposes;

13. Entry and Exit of the following shall be allowed, subject to proper presentation of Valid Identification Cards/Quarantine Passes/Frontliner IDs/Employment Certificate/Company IDs/Medical Certificate and other necessary documents:


- a. Health workers, utilities and staff;
- b. Authorized Government Officials and government frontline personnel;
- c. Those travelling for emergency or urgent and necessary medical or humanitarian reasons;
- d. Labor and workforce of sectors/establishments allowed to operate;
- e. Persons providing essential goods and services and public utilities;
- f. Deliveries of goods and commodities, medicines, medical equipment, construction supplies and others relating to trade and commerce;
- g. All others with essential and authorized purpose

SECTION 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Executive Order is declared invalid and unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid;

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain as such until lifted, amended or repealed.
